

WHAT IS CENTRAL ARIZONA PROJECT?

Central Arizona Project (CAP) is a 336-mile system that brings water to central and southern Arizona. CAP supplies water to 80% of the state's population, and is the single largest provider of water to Native American Tribes in the Colorado River system.



THE CAP SYSTEM IS AN ENGINEERING MARVEL

Construction of the \$4 billion CAP system began in 1973 and was completed 20 years later. The result is an engineering marvel.
